## Florida Foster Child Scholarship Application Instructions

## Student Eligibility

A student who is/was placed at any time in foster care or out-of-home care during the current OR previous state fiscal year may be eligible (the state fiscal year runs from July 1 to June 30).

A child in foster care is defined by the following:

"Foster care" means care provided a child in a foster family or boarding home, group home, agency boarding home, child care institution, or any combination thereof, as defined by s. 39.01(29) f.s..

A child in out-of-home care placement is defined by the following:

"Out-of-home" means a placement outside of the home of the parents or a parent, as defined by s. 39.01(48) f.s. which is further defined as the placement of a child in licensed and non-licensed settings, arranged and supervised by the department or contracted service provider, outside of the home of the parent, as defined by DCF Rule: 65C-30.001 Definitions. (91).

Documentation from the state of Florida that validates that the child meets the definition of s.39.01(29) or s. 39.01(48) must accompany the application for scholarship assistance. Failure to provide this documentation will result in the application being denied.

<u>Children who **DO NOT** meet the above criteria</u> must use the 2023-2024 Florida income-based scholarship application that is available at <a href="https://www.aaascholarships.org">www.aaascholarships.org</a> and must meet the following criteria for scholarship assistance:

- 1. Student must reside in the state of Florida.
- 2. Student must be at least five years old by September 1, 2023 if entering kindergarten.
- 3. Student must not have graduated from high school or reached the age of 21, whichever comes first.
- 4. Guardians must provide documentation of #1 & #2 noted above with their application package.

<u>NEW:</u> Once processing of this application is complete, you will receive an EMAIL from us letting you know that a determination has been made. You will then click a link to access our new online Scholarship Management Platform (SMP). This new online system will make it quick, easy, and simple for you to manage this child's AAA scholarship account. This child's scholarship Determination Letter and School Commitment Form (for qualified students) will <u>only</u> be available for you to view, print, and accept on AAA's new online SMP.
